Worship Service Changes: Communion and Peace: Starting today for Holy Communion services, a common cup station and a pouring chalice station will be reinstated. There will continue to be a small tray of pre-poured juice glasses. Masks will be worn by those distributing if they are sick or members of their household are sick. Tongs for wafer distribution will be discontinued. Likewise, starting today, ministers will again go down the aisles sharing the peace with those who want to participate.
