Worship Notes

Communion: For those wanting to receive, you will be offered bread, wine and grape juice for Communion. When waiting in line, please leave 2 meters distance between you and the person ahead of you. The pastor will drop the wafer into your outstretched hands with tongs. The wine will be pre-poured in individual cups placed in a tray on tables (the juice is in the small tray). Please take a cup and your wafer to consume near the baptismal area (where you may remove your mask). The cups may be disposed of in a basket on the front pew. If you do not want to partake in the wine or juice, you are welcome to take the wafer back to your pew.

As it was pre-pandemic, the front pews will commune first (as invited by the usher), and the flow will be up the centre aisle, then returning to your seats via the side aisles. Please be patient as we only want to have one household taking off their masks by the font at a time.

This morning we welcome the Guitar Choir from Mount Zion, Waterloo to our worship. Thank you for helping us to lift our voices in song!

This short fugue is perfect for Trinity Sunday as the 3 voices are distinct and woven together just like the 3 Persons of the Trinity. You will hear the high clear voice in the right hand, the lower oboe sound in the left hand and the third voice in the pedal division. Imagine them dancing together!

Important Information for today's worship

- **Masks:** According to our church's current protocols, you may remove your mask when you are in your pew, or while eating or drinking. Apart from these exceptions, wearing a mask continues to be mandatory indoors for St. Matthews members, events and meetings.
