

Update on Phone System Outage:

Dear Congregation Members,

We apologize for the length of time it has taken to get the phone system back up and running. We understand the inconvenience this has caused.

There's been many circumstances, such as staff vacations, waiting for responses from companies who might be able to repair the old system, and investigating and getting pricing on a new Voice Over Internet Protocol (VOIP), which is the reason for the delay.

We have learned the existing old telephone system cannot be repaired. We are currently getting quotes from two individuals on the VOIP system and we are targeting to have the phones operational by mid September barring there are no delays in getting the equipment that is required.

We appreciate your understanding while we work on getting the telephone system operational.
