Music notes: The composer of this morning's organ prelude is William France, longtime organist of Dominion-Chalmers United Church in Ottawa. The postlude was composed by David Ouchterlony, for many years organist at Timothy Eaton Memorial Church in Toronto. The choir anthem was attributed to Orlando Gibbons for most of the 20th century, though recent scholarship points to the work originating with his contemporary Henry Loosemore, who served as organist at King's College, Cambridge.
